

CAMOUFLAGE NET



OVERVIEW

The Imperial Armour camouflage net has been used extensively in South Africa and in other parts of the world as an effective means of disguise. The basic "carrier net" is made from Nylon and provides heat, weather and flame resistance.

STYLE

- The net is NIR(Near Infrared). The IR reflection is between 20% and 58% from underneath the net
- The net has rings retained by a surround braid which can be attached to any object.
- Fixed with joining cords to enable you to join 2 or more nets together
- The net is packed into a bag made of HDPE Shadenet.

SIZES

The standard Vehicle covering net is 10,2 x 10,2 meters but Imperial Armour can produce any required size.

WEIGHT

The net weighs 350 grams per square meter

COLOURS

- The leaf pattern was designed by a botanist and is battle proven
- The colour combination fits in with Bushy and Desert areas because of the double side of the product. (2D)
- The 3 colours of the material are there to reduce the identifiability of the object underneath the net. The colour of the paint has certain functions to help with the wavelengths to establish and identify objects. The net protects the object from wavelengths up to 800 Nanometers.

PROTECTION

- Resistant to heat: No change in colours and shape when stored at 70°C over a period of one week
- Fire retardant as per DIN 53438
- Water and moisture resistant
- Camouflages effectively in the visual range as well as in the near I.R. range
